Thus I have an RC3 looper which is great too. There is a lot of room for adjusting it to get exactly what you want out of it. I still haven't learned how to use the reverse delay, and it seems to be slightly less userfriendly than the one on the BOSS ME50, so that's a possible drawback. If you have very advanced delay sounds in your set, it's not easy to fiddle with it on stage, but I've gotten along fine switching back and forth between two or three settings with no issue.

The fact that you can dial in so many different recognizable sounds makes this purchase worth more than any other DD pedals. Only gave it 3 stars because there are many pedals out there that sound just as good with many more features at this price point. Sounds great, as most boss pedals do. Just not very versatile for the money. Modulation option with short delay time can basically act as a

chorus pedal. Vintage sound option is also very good. No noise to speak of. It definitely is one of the best if not the best delay pedal out there. It does everything you can think of when it comes to delay and even has a modulate mode which you can create a chorus sound from. The tap tempo is the most convenient for me and is the thing I use most with this pedal. I have come to realize that I probably will never use this pedal to its full potential. But it is a great pedal and I recommend it to anyone who wants to use all of the many features. If you're like me and just want a good quality delay pedal with a tap tempo feature, I would get something a little less complicated and a little cheaper.
